



This document provides step-by-step instructions to complete the invitation acceptance process.




Berkshire Hathaway Energy requires use of a Microsoft account to provide secure access to its system. A Microsoft 365 business account can be used to provide single sign-on. If your business does not use Microsoft 365, a consumer Microsoft account can be used.





1	<p>Open the invitation email from: <i>Microsoft Invitations on behalf of B2B Berkshire Hathaway Energy B2B</i></p> <hr/> <p>Select the Accept Invitation link</p>	
2	<p>If you are signed in with the Microsoft account the invitation was sent to, choose the account; if not, enter the email address the invitation was sent to, select Next, then enter the password</p>	
3	<p>Select Accept</p> <p>NOTE: The permissions granted allow access to basic profile information and collects activity within Berkshire Hathaway Energy's system</p>





Berkshire Hathaway Energy requires use of multifactor authentication to provide secure access to its system. If your business uses Microsoft 365 and your account does not have multifactor authentication enabled, you will be redirected to Microsoft 365 to enroll in multifactor authentication. Once enrolled, you will be redirected back to Berkshire Hathaway Energy’s system to finish the invitation acceptance process.



NOTE: Your options for enrolling in multifactor authentication are based on policies set by your IT department. Berkshire Hathaway Energy prefers Microsoft Authenticator but accepts other authenticators if your business has a different preference.
